- Glue






a magic plant that converts CO<sup>2</sup> into O<sup>2</sup>.







Can turn all plastic into healthy fish food.




Vacuum-bazooka canon that compresses and shoots trash into the sun which incinerates it.







Magic hairdryer to suck the air pollution and transform it into oxygen.




Neutra-gun to transform toxic waste into fertilizer.



Gloves that reverse ice caps melting.






Magic axe which duplicates trees every time you cut one down.




Sieve to remove the bacteria and oil spills
