<u>Corporate Services Scrutiny Panel</u> Child Tax Allowance and Childcare Tax Allowance

The Panel is currently reviewing the Government Plan 2021-24 and has highlighted that there has, again, been no increase in the child tax allowance or childcare tax allowance.

Households with a child under the age of 16 can currently claim a marginal tax rate exemption of £3,000. The additional child allowance available to single parents is £4,500. This has not been increased since 2011. The childcare allowances are available to all parents. Households with children aged between 4-12 can claim "Child Care Tax Relief" up to £6,150, this has not increased since 2017.

The Panel is currently evaluating the practicality of bringing an amendment forward to increase these allowances in the Government Plan 2021-24 and the Panel would be very interested in obtaining your view on the matter.

With a reduced lodging period of the Government Plan this year the Panel have been conducting Scrutiny of it in a tight timescale, as such we would be most grateful if you could share your views with us by Tuesday 24th November 2020.
